Foundation Grants

GRANT RECIPIEN

The Jim Mora Count On Me Family Foundation awarded \$66,300 in grants, as well as over \$13,000 in donations, to seventeen charitable organizations in Washington and Georgia for the 2010 grant cycle. Funds for this year's grants were raised through the Annual Jim Mora Celebrity Golf Classic, the Lucky Strike Bowling Benefit Bash, Ladies Night Out, and many generous donations from corporations and individuals.

The Foundation also collaborated with many of the recipients on in-kind donations and outreach. The Foundation awards grants and partners with charities and organizations whose mission aligns with ours: to support children from a low socio-economic background, children who are mentally and/or physically challenged, and children at risk. The Jim Mora Flag Football League

The Jim Mora Count On Me Family Foundation has partnered with the Boys and Girls Clubs since 2005 to provide funding and encourage involvement in their co-ed Flag Football League for boys and girls ages 9-11. Youth in the metro Atlanta and Bellevue clubs compete against other club members through an in-house game schedule.
